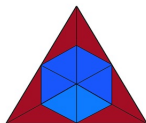


Alignment

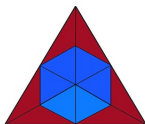
Aligned vertically:

► First

Using the package `graphbox`, we can set `align=c`:

```
\includegraphics[align=c]
```

Because the text is of different size, the images are not aligned horizontally in a column.

Alignment

Aligned vertically, horizontally with minipage for text :



The `\fbox` around the text lets one see the box size — to be deleted after calibration.

Aligned vertically:

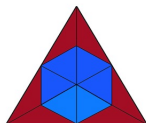


Here we just place the images (of the same size) first in order to maintain alignment.

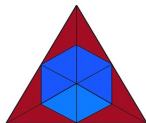
Aligned horizontally in tabular and vertically with minipage:

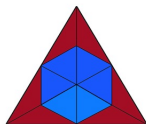

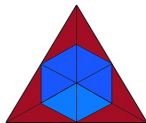
Aligned horizontally in tabular and vertically with graphbox :
